BY-LAWS

AIR FARES

- 1.1. The Society shall pay 70% of the economy return air fare to the two delegates attending the National Rose Society of Australia's AGM.

AWARDS

- 2.1 AUSTRALIAN ROSE AWARD – Rules – Australian Rose Annual 1989 page 20. See Appendix "A" (reference only - Australia and New Zealand).
- 2.2 BERT MULLEY MEMORIAL AWARD - Rules – NSW Rose, March, 1990 page 13. See Appendix "B".
- 2.3 Sub Committee – Authority of - Empowered to make decisions regarding potential recipients of the ARA, the SMA and the BMMA.

T. A. STEWART MEMORIAL AWARD – Trust Deed -See Appendix "C" – (reference only – NRSA).

JUDGES

- 3.1 Expenses: Rose Society Shows - Out of pocket expenses and one (1) night's accommodation where applicable.
- 3.2 Fees: charges to other Societies – Metropolitan Area \$20, Non-Metropolitan \$30 plus out of pocket expenses including accommodation where applicable.
- 3.3 Probationary - Rules for –See Appendix "D".

MEMBERSHIP

- 4.1 Definition – Clause 2 (b) (i) of the Constitution. Membership shall consist of 1 or 2 adults residing in the one residence for whom only one membership subscription is payable, provided that both names appear in the Membership Register, having satisfied Clause 2 (a), (i) or (ii) of the Constitution.
- 4.2 Honorary Life Membership - To be awarded only by State Council and only after a review by the Awards Sub. Committee.

- 4.3 Subscription Part Year – Full annual subscription paid at all times. Up until the 30th April (or until the supply of Australian Rose Annuals is exhausted) full subscription and member financial to 30th June of the current year. After, whichever occurs first of the foregoing, full subscription at next year's rate and member then financial to 30th June of the following year. Any Australian Rose Annuals remaining to be offered at cost plus postage. Subscription Secretary to advise.
- 4.4 Twenty Five Years Membership – After 25 years continuous membership a Member or both joint Members will be awarded a commemorative badge.

SHOWS

- 5.1 Regulations - 'Appendix "E", Show Regulations', adopted by State Council 12th February, 2006.
- 5.2 Schedules - 'Appendix "F", Show Schedule', adopted by State Council 15th May 2005.
- 5.3 Schedules - Alterations to Standards, only after review by the Judges Panel.
- 5.4 Schedules - Standard Units – As defined in the Standard Show Schedule (Appendix "F"), page 1, adopted by State Council 15th May 2005.

SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

- 6.1 Charges for - Members are to be charged a nominal amount for any subsidized social function. If separate accounts are organized to cover the costs, they are to be so specified in the Annual Statement.
- 6.2 Participation of non-members - For other than Society Members as in Clause 2 of the Constitution (as defined in these By-Laws) and in accordance with Clause 30 (1) the participation of friends, guests or children shall be at the discretion of the organizing committee.

STANDING ORDERS

- 7.1 With reference to Clauses 4 (d) and 24 (d) of the Constitution, Standing Orders as contained in Appendix 4 of "A Guide for Meetings and Organisations" by N.E. Renton are to be adopted.
