THE KIAMA SHORES MOTEL

This is a very comfortable motel located in the centre of the Kiama CBD with ready access to walks along the bay area, to cafes and restaurants, and a 1km or 12-minute walk along the shoreline to the Pavilion. Breakfast is served at the Three Brother's Café adjoining the Motel.

TRAIN

Train leaves regularly from the Domestic Airport - one stop to Wollie Creek Station to take the South Coast Line to Kiama Station (a 2-hour journey and a 7- minute walk from the station to the Kiama Shores Motel).

CAR

1.5-2 hour-trip down the coast to Kiama via F6 Southern Freeway from Sydney CBD or Airport
